Congratulations to pupils in Oak, Birch & Sycamore class this week who came **1st with 100% of pupils** reading at least 4 times each week.

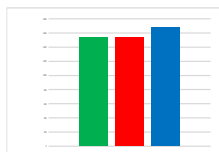

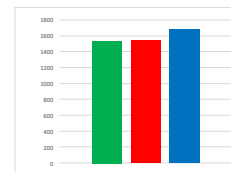
Which house is in the lead so far this term?
