Dear Parents/Carers



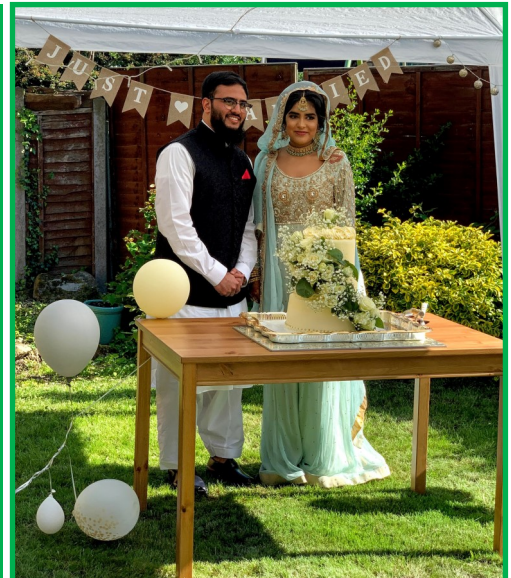
As we start the final half term, summer is most definitely here! Please can I ask parents to make sure your child has sun cream and a hat in their school bag.

Congratulations to Mrs Usman:

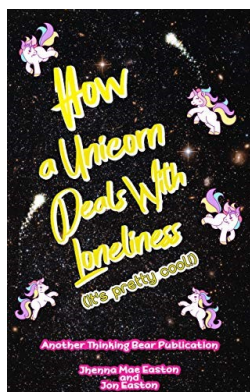
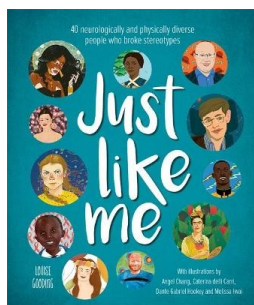

Please can you support us in encouraging your child to read at least 4 times per week & ensure that they bring their signed Reading Records into school. Thank you.

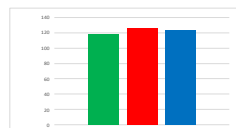

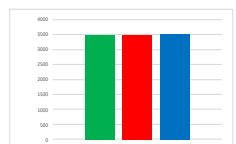


Which house is in the lead so far overall?
