Congratulations to the Governors Core Values Award winners. This Award has been given in recognition of those children who have consistently demonstrated our Core Values for the whole of the academic year.

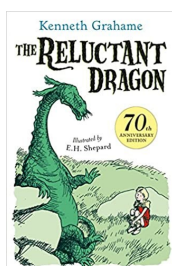

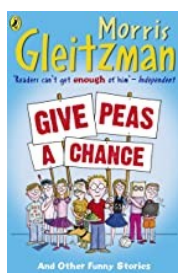

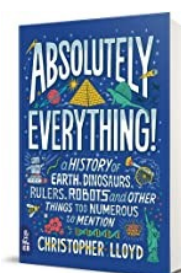
