Headteacher's Message: Dear Parents/Carers

Happy New Year! The children have settled back into School and new topics have commenced.

Please can I remind Parents that as from Tuesday this week, pupils who receive a positive lateral flow test but has no COVID-19 symptoms, will no longer be required to take a PCR to confirm the result. Also, from Monday 17th January, pupils who test positive will have the option to reduce their isolation period after 5 full days if they test negative with a lateral flow device (LFD) test on both day 5 and day 6 (and they do not have a temperature) eq. if they test negative on the morning of day 5 and the morning of day 6, they can return to school on day 6.

We hope to be able to start Spring Term Clubs shortly if government guidelines allow. More information to follow.
