Year 3 - In Science this week, the children looked at similarities and differences between various vertebrates and used these to identify them and put into the correct vertebrate groups.

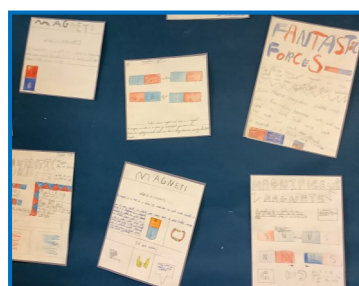


Year 5 used their printing blocks to create Greek patterns.

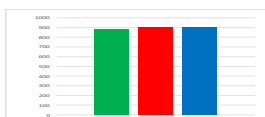
Well done and a **BIG** thank you to everyone that took part in the Sponsored Reading Challenge. We raised an impressive **£542.60**
