Providing this additional resource to support early intervention, appropriate signposting and delivery of focused, evidence-based interventions will improve collaboration between schools and mental health services and enable earlier and more effective mental health support for children, young people, their families and carers. Holiday Free School Meal Voucher Scheme

all you need to know for the winter holiday period 2022

For the winter holiday period, the holiday free school meal voucher scheme will be distributing two weeks of vouchers for every eligible child signed up to the scheme.

Each eligible child will receive a total of £30 for the two-week holiday.

Your child is eligible if they meet all of the following criteria:


- Your child attends a school in Gloucestershire
- Your child is in reception to year 11
- Your child is eligible for benefits related, pupil premium free school meals*

We confirm this by checking our term-time free school meal register so make sure you are registered. You can register by clicking here.

*Please note this does not include infant free school meals available to all children in reception to year 2.

What you can do to make sure you receive your voucher first time:

On your email inbox settings, add the email selectcode@select-your-reward.co.uk to your safe sender list so that the voucher does not end up in your junk/spam



If you haven't already applied to the Holiday Free School Meal (FSM) voucher scheme, you can can register by visiting our application page.

Applications for the Holiday FSM voucher scheme close at midday on the 6 December.

Vouchers for the winter period will be distributed on the 13 December
